When an artist cites the likes of Prince, Trent Reznor and The Beatles as influences, it's anyone's guess as to what you might end up with. In the case of Chris Koster's followup to his 2005 debut, it's refreshingly none of the above, but instead an electro/rock hybrid that blazes a trail of its own. Recorded at The Tragically Hip's studio in Bath, Ontario, this album is loaded with equal parts dance floor jams ("Constantly") and rock club bangers ("Conceited"). On *Sex, Love & Morality*, digital wizardry meets rock 'n' roll in its purest sense, held seamlessly together by Koster's croon-to-clamour vocal acrobatics. — **Jamie Hunter**
