## Chris Koster, Sex Love & Morality

Kingston, Ont.'s Chris Koster's second disc is an unusual listen and very hard to place. First off, *Sex, Love & Morality* is heavily influenced by R&B icons Prince and Michael Jackson, and like his influences, Koster is blessed with a golden voice that can change from a soft whisper to a razor-whipped growl on command. Along with this gift of genuine soul, Koster takes his pop vision one step further turning the alternative rock guitars loose, making songs like "I Don't Feel Like Dancing," "Temporary Lovers" and "Montreal" even more dramatic and catchy. *Morality's* is overproduced (for a perfect example see "No Love Loss"), but Koster makes his statement with a truly unique sound.
